SPECIAL CALLED MEETING – CANVASSING ELECTION HUTCHINS CITY COUNCIL MONDAY, May 13, 2019 RECEPTION – 6:00 P.M. REGULAR MEETING – 6:30 P.M.

A Special Called Meeting of the Hutchins City Council was held on Monday, May 13, 2019 at 6:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers located in City Hall at 321 N. Main St., Hutchins, Texas, at which time the following items were discussed and considered, pursuant to Section 551 of the Texas Government Code.

RECEPTION:

A reception was held in recognition of the service of outgoing Councilmember Brenda Campbell and in honor of returning Councilmember Raymond Elmore and Councilmember Demarcus Odom, and incoming Councilmember Freddie Chism. Mrs. Campbell thanked the council and staff. Mayor Vasquez thanked Mrs. Campbell for her services and presented her with a plaque commemorating her years of service. Chris Fason, President of the Hutchins Professional Firefighters Association, presented outgoing City Councilmember Brenda Campbell with a personalized Challenge Coin. Mr. Fason also presented personalized Challenge Coins to City Administrator Lewis, Mayor Vasquez and Councilmembers.
