City Council meetings are held on the first and third Monday of each month with the exception of the months of November and December, which will have one meeting each. Minutes of past City Council meetings can be found at www.cityofhutchins.org.

Qualifications to run for City Council

1. Must be a citizen of the United States.
2. Must be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as applicable.
3. Must not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be:
(A) totally mentally incapacitated; or
(B) partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.
4. Must not have been finally convicted of a felony for which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.
5. Must have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and in the territory from which the office is elected for six months immediately preceding the following dates:
On the date described by Subdivision 5, be registered to vote in the territory from which the office is elected;
and
6. Must satisfy any other eligibility requirements prescribed by law for the office.

Filing Period

An application for a place on the ballot can be obtained from the Office of the City Secretary and submitted to that office beginning January 18, 2023, through February 17, 2023, by 5:00p.m.
