The City of Hutchins will take action on Monday, February 6, 2023 to Call the Election on Saturday, May 6, 2023 for the purpose of electing three (3) city council members at large for two (2) year terms.

### Deadline to File Application for a Place on the Ballot

The filing period for an Application for a Place on the Ballot in the May 6, 2023 General Election is Wednesday, January 18, 2023 through Friday, February 17, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. The last day to file as a write-in candidate will be February 21, 2023.

## 2023 BOARDS/COMMISSION RECRUITMENT

First time applicants must submit an application by June 1st.**

- ◆ All board and commission applicants are appointed by the City Council each July. The appointment process is managed through the Office of the City Secretary.
- ◆ All appointees to City of Hutchins boards, commissions, and committees must be residents of Hutchins unless the ordinance requires representation from the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) or other membership composition requirements
- ◆ All applicants will receive a copy of and must adhere to the attendance policy established by the City Council. Each board or commission elects its own chairperson and officers.
