Geographical Information System

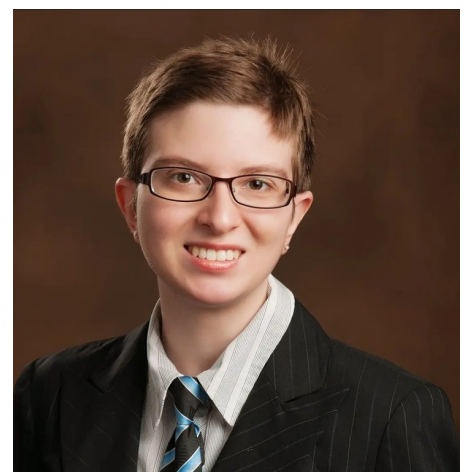
The City will initiate the Geographical Information System (GIS) project beginning in January 2023. A Geographical Information System is designed to capture, store, manipulate, analyze, manage, and present all types of geographical data. Once completed, information will be easily available regarding streets, water, utilities, subdivisions, master thoroughfare plan, zoning, maps, future land use plans, parks and recreation, and more - this project should be operational by mid 2023. Council approved this project in the FY 2022/2023 budget.

City Website

The City has begun the process of developing a new website. The website will be user friendly and provide needed information regarding meetings, department operations, and services. The expected date to make the website operational is May 2023. Funding of the project was approved by City Council in the FY 2022-2023 budget.

New Smart Water Meter Notice of Installation

The City of Hutchins will be upgrading your property's water meter to an advanced metering technology. The meter will positively impact both the environment and the City's ability to serve your water needs accurately and efficiently. Hutchins has contracted with Aqua Metric to perform the meter change-out. Aqua Metric technicians will be working in the City of Hutchins over the next three months. The Aqua Metric technician will be clearly identifiable with a company identification badge. You are not required to be present during the meter change out and there should be no damage to your property surrounding the meter box. Upon arrival, Aqua Metric technicians will attempt to notify anyone at the property of a brief water outage. Your water service will be temporarily disconnected for approximately 3 – 5 minutes to replace the existing meter. This entire process should take approximately 20 minutes to complete.
